Curriculum Committee Report

The Curriculum Committee completed the Spring 2023 schedule and has arranged for the printing and posting of the schedule. Mailing of the schedule will be done by the Communication and Support Committee. There are 70 classes listed in the Spring 2023 schedule: 27 at Dobson, 16 at Red Mountain, 17 online, and 11 off-site. Two intersession courses will be offered this year: a 3-session workshop by Nancy Spence at Unity Center and an online session by Jennifer Wong in partnership with RISE of Rio Salado CC. Registration will be open Tuesday, January 24, 2023. Facilitators and presenters have been invited to attend the Open House on January 20, 2023.

A virtual preview of the schedule will be posted to the website prior to the Open House. No virtual presentation is planned.

The Fall Term finished with good attendance overall. Attendance statistics were not available at the time of this report.

Coordination with other Lifelong Learning program continues with joint online programs being offered in the Spring with New Adventures in Learning at Chandler-Gilbert CC and RISE at Rio Salado CC. A partnership with MCC Civic Engagement is being explored based on an invitation to participate initiated by Civic Engagement. Three programs have been scheduled with Venture Out Resort in the Spring to encourage membership.

The committee continues to work on revision of the Facilitator Handbook, communications, technology training, and role definition for members.
