

Curriculum Committee Report to NFLL Council

The Curriculum Committee has worked this month to implement the Fall Courses and support presenters and facilitators as needed. Proposals for the Spring courses have been solicited; deadline was Nov. 1 but the deadline has been extended to Nov 15. The Curriculum Chair will meet with NAIL representatives to review the joint classes this term and implement changes to make courses go smoothly.

Attendance has been good for most classes. No shows continue to be a problem with up to 40% no shows in some classes. Online class attendance has been good with most classes having 12-16 attendees and some classes having 40 attendees.

A guide for operating the computer system has been developed and is available on request. MCC Technology has implemented on-site support and this has helped facilitators with issues.
