## COVID-19 Return to College Acknowledgements New Frontier

Mesa Community College (MCC) requires all students registered for Fall 2021 in-person and hybrid (online/in-person) classes to complete this acknowledgement in accordance with MCC Covid-19 student return to campus policy. ### MCC Face Covering Requirement

1. Face coverings are still required for staff, faculty, students, police, and guests inside all Maricopa buildings. While the CDC guidelines state that fully vaccinated individuals do not need face-coverings in certain situations, it still asks individuals to wear face coverings around others indoors until more people are vaccinated, as this provides protection for those at high risk. However, face coverings are no longer required when an individual is outside.
2. Face shields are not considered appropriate face coverings unless worn with a face mask underneath.
3. Students seeking medical/health accommodation in an attempt to refrain from wearing the required face covering/mask must be registered with and approved for such an accommodation by the MCC Disability Resources Office
4. Students seeking religious accommodations in an attempt to refrain from wearing a face mask or covering must contact the Dean of Students and/or Dean of Academic Affairs office and engage in the MCCCC ND-4 [Religious Accommodation and Procedure](#) accommodation process.
5. All students seeking an accommodation (either for medical/health or for religious reasons) must continue to wear face covering while indoors on the MCCCC/MCC properties until such accommodations are approved.

- \*  I understand that Mesa Community College has policies and protocols in order to help stop the spread of COVID-19. I agree to abide by the College's policies and protocols for COVID-19 at all times while on the College's property.
- \*  I understand that MCC policy requires students, faculty and staff to wear a face covering or mask while being on the college property unless they have a college-approved accommodation. This includes classrooms, common areas, outdoor and indoor walkways, parking lots and other campus locations.
- \*  I understand that it is my responsibility to seek approvals for medical/health exemptions with the MCC Disability Resources Office. I understand that I am still required to wear a face covering/mask, or refrain from coming to campus until such a request is approved.
- \*  I understand that it is my responsibility to seek approvals for religious exemption through the MCCCC ND-4 Religious Accommodation and Procedures process.
- \*  I understand that I am still required to wear a face covering/mask while on MCCCC/MCC properties, or refrain from coming to campus until such a request is approved.
- \*  I understand that failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary action under the MCCCC Student Code of Conduct policy.

### Covid Reporting Requirements

Members of the Maricopa County Community College community must notify Risk Management if they are diagnosed with COVID-19 or if they believe they have been exposed to COVID-19. **This includes students who are enrolled in either in-person, hybrid (in-person and online combination) and/or online classes.**

Your personally identifiable information, including name, address, and medical conditions will remain confidential and will not be shared with instructors, other students, or staff but your information may be shared with local health authorities as permitted under the ADA.

### Stop the Spread

**COVID-19** spreads mainly among people who are in close contact (within about three (3) feet) for a prolonged period. Spread happens when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks, and droplets from their mouth or nose are launched into the air and come in contact with the mouths or noses of people nearby.

- \*  I will stay home when I am sick, if I have a fever of 100.3 or above, or if I have tested positive for COVID-19
- \*  I understand that I may communicate any concerns to my instructor or the department chair and may contact the Dean of Students/Academic Affairs if I am needing information on MCC COVID-19 procedures
- \*  I will take all precautions to stop the spread including practicing good hygiene (washing hands, using hand sanitizer, covering coughs/sneezes, etc.).
- \*  I understand that some areas of the campus are restricted at this time.

## **Maintaining a Clean Environment**

Documentation shows that the cleaning of visibly dirty surfaces, followed by disinfection, is a best practice measure for prevention of COVID-19 and other viral respiratory illnesses.
