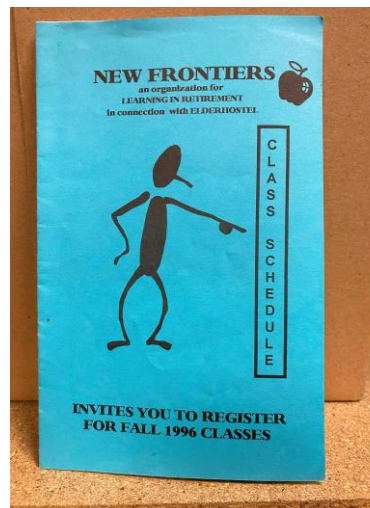
Blast From the Past

Share dreams and discuss interpretations.



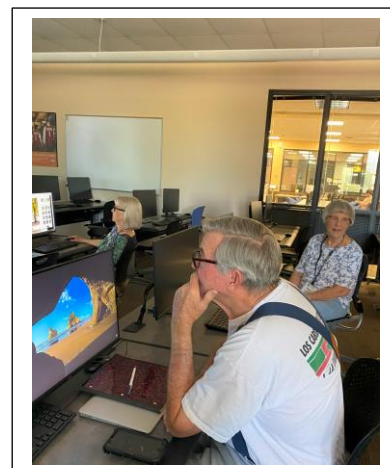
Back to School – NFLL Fall Class Schedule is Available!
